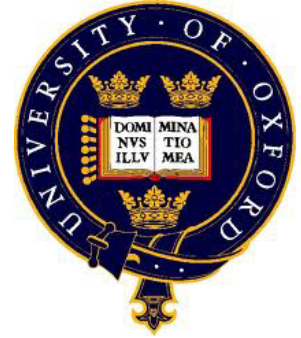




Open Society Foundations / University of Oxford Scholarships 2013-2014



The Center for International Education welcomes applications from citizens of Georgia for the Open Society Foundations/University of Oxford Scholarships 2013-2014, which are jointly funded by the Open Society Foundation- London and the University of Oxford.

Scholarships are for selected one year taught Masters courses within the **University of Oxford's Social Sciences and Humanities Divisions**.

Each scholarship provides one year's tuition fees and college fees at the University of Oxford, a stipend to cover living costs (for one person only), and return air travel from the scholar's home country. On completion of the scholarship, scholars will return to their home countries.

Applicants must have excellent academic qualifications and a fluent command of the English language.

You can apply to the University either on-line or on paper, but in second case you are responsible for sending the application package to the University.

All applications must be received by the University of Oxford by Friday 18th January 2013.

It is expected that interviews of short-listed candidates will be held in Tbilisi in April 2013; precise dates to be announced nearer the time. Please note: only candidates who are available for interview will be considered.
