## REQUIREMENTS TO ARTICLES:

The text volume of 10-15 pages. The text editor Word, 14 size, typeface Times New Roman; line spacing - 1,5; upper and lower right - 2 cm, left - 2.5 cm, right - 1,5 cm; paragraph - 1.25 cm.

On the first page of a paragraph:

in the first line - **UDC** (left);

next line - surname, name and patronymic in the nominative case (identified in bold direct); degree, academic rank, position, place of work of the author (no abbreviations!); If several authors, information about each submitted separate lines); email address

**Personal number of the author (s) ORCID (required)!**

next line - article title (centered in capital letters, bold highlight)

next line Abstract

**Abstract** articles in English must meet the following requirements informative (excluding common words); original (not copy a shortened abstract submitted in the national language); consistency (show the basic content articles and research results); structuring (perhaps even headings, as in the article: subject, topic, purpose, method or methodology, results, scope of results, conclusions); compactness.

next line - Keywords (5-7 words);

After annotations - The main text of the article;

The text in bold italics to highlight words: *problem, object of the paper, the results, conclusions and perspectives for future research.*

After the text of the article - REFERENCES (centered highlight in bold).

After the text of the article in the first line of Ukrainian language and surname in the nominative case (identified in bold direct); degree, academic rank, position, place of work of the author (unabridged); If several authors, information about each submitted separate lines)

next line - article title (centered in capital letters, highlight bold, Ukrainian.

next line Abstract language articles (5-6 sentences), Ukrainian;

next line - Keywords (5-7 words), Ukrainian.

After the text of the article in the first line of Russian language and surname in the nominative case (identified in bold direct); degree, academic rank, position, place of work of the author (unabridged); If several authors, information about each submitted separate lines)

next line - article title (centered in capital letters, highlight bold, Russian.

next line Abstract language articles (5-6 sentences), Russian;

next line - Keywords (5-7 words), Russian.

Also is a list of literature (transliterated) (REFERENCES), which should give completely separate block, repeating references, provided the national language, regardless of whether it is foreign sources or not. If there is a reference to foreign publications, they are fully repeated in the list provided in the Latin alphabet.
